Take care to empty any ponds or standing water, thus not letting mosquitoes breed and multiply. Keep your horse clean, sprayed with repellent and perhaps covered with a summer flysheet. 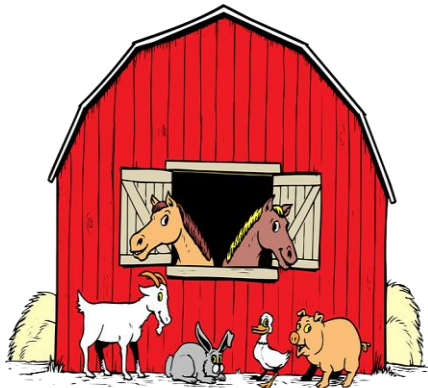
