She hurt her shoulder as it broke her fall in the water, and was thrown against saddle horn as he cranked up the power to disengage from his watery captivity. However, her efforts undoubtedly, saved them from more deadly abuse from the river.</p> <p>It became apparent the trail she found herself on was not a familiar route. As she and Jesse continued blazing the trail as they came upon a river crossing. Jesse stepped into the water and realized that the sand was clamping down on his hoof as he sank into the silky, soft quicksand. He lunged to disengage himself from its grip, he lunged again.....Sharon bailed off Jessie's back to give him all the freedom possible to dislodge himself from the quicksand that had a hold of him. Her next fear that griped her soul; was Jessie going to bolt once he got out of the river... she prayed!!! Jessie swam; maneuvering the deep "potholes of water," to the other side, walked out of the river water, and stood waiting for her to join him so they could both go home.</p> <p>This is a true reminder that the commonplace and routine of our river and the riverbed in general, can turn treacherous at any given moment.
